- Direktflüge mit Iberia, Tap Portugal, Air France, KLM & bald Lufthansa (März 2016)
- Panama ist das einzige Land weltweit, wo man den Sonnenaufgang über dem Pazifik und den – untergang über dem Atlantik am selben Tag sehen kann.
- Panama bedeutet Überfluss an Schmetterlingen und Fischen in seiner Ureinwohnersprache.
- Erleben Sie den Panama Kanal als einzigartiges von Menschenhand geschaffenes Industriewunder.
- Panama Stadt ist die einzige Hauptstadt weltweit mit einem Regenwald innerhalb seiner Stadtgrenzen.
- Der Panama Hut ist ursprünglich aus Ecuador und wird immer noch dort gefertigt.

Activities & Excursions



Panama Canal Transit

Rent a private vessel and cross the Miraflores & Pedro Miguel Locks along side the massive container ships to experience the Canal first hand. This experience comes complete with food, drinks and music on board.

Duration: approx. 6 hours, Max. Capacity: 400pax per boat



Historical Highlights Tour

Discover 3 cities in one day: Panama La Vieja (the first settlement), The Casco Viejo (Old Quarter and UNESCO World Heritage Site), and modern Panama City by bus and on foot.

Duration: approx. 6 hours, Max. Capacity: 300pax / round (2 rounds / day)



The Unknown Historical Quarter

Get to know The Casco (Old Quarter) in a different way. Now a beautiful touristic area it once was the Red Zone. Explore its cobble stone streets with a walking tour guided by former gang members who changed their lives & now dedicate themselves to telling the "behind the scenes" story of The Casco. Duration: approx. 3 hours, Max. Capacity: 150pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Panama Canal Visit

See the Panama Canal in action front row at the Miraflores Locks, where the container ships are elevated from their current altitude to the next. The Miraflores visitor Center offers viewing terraces, 3D movies and a 4 story museum.

Duration: approx. 4 hours, Max. Capacity: 150pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Embera Indigenous Village

Few places on this earth still exist untouched by modern life, and the Embera indigenous village is one of them. Take a journey deep into the rainforest to visit the Embera people & live their life for a day through cultural education, tours, local food tasting, craft making, and learning traditional songs and dances. Duration: approx. 6 hours, Max. Capacity: 150pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Gamboa Rainforest Experience

See the Gamboa Rainforest up close & personal by aerial tram, walking through it, going up an outlook post for views above the canopy, & boat expeditions that take you through the Chagres river to spot wildlife & pass the container ships on the Panama Canal.
Duration: approx. 6 hours, Max. Capacity: 200pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Train Ride along Panama Canal

This historical train tour connects two oceans within one day and will take you back to the colonial times of Panama! Only here in Panama, you will be able to have breakfast at the Pacific, then to have lunch at the Atlantic Ocean and to be back for dinner at the Pacific Ocean!

Duration: approx. 2 hours, Max. Capacity: 200pax / round (1 round / day)



Portobelo Village Discovery

Situated on the Atlantic side of Panama, Portobelo is a former Spanish village rich with African heritage. A wonderful cultural experience, see how these two cultures have formed as one through local interaction, a village tour, & tasting of local gastronomy.

Duration: approx. 6 hours, Max. Capacity: 40pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Flavors of Panama

During this walking tour in the Casco Viejo, we will invite you to discover the flavours of Panama: Taste one of the best coffees in the world, the Geisha coffee, get a gourmet ice-cream in a small ice shop, make your own shaved ice, try out Panamanian chocolate and enjoy artisan crafts beer in a local beer shop. Duration: approx. 4 hours, Max. Capacity: 40pax / round (2 rounds / day)



Chiva Parrandera Party Bus

Take this tour to get the feeling of the Panamanian way of diversion! We will hire a private Chiva Parrandera with open windows, colorful decorated with urban paintings, lights, and have on board a DJ and a mobile bar to make the trip even more fun! Duration: approx. 3 hours, Max. Capacity: 25pax seated



Tropical Zoo Discovery

This brand-new and recently opened Tropical Zoo is home to White-headed Capuchins, Spider Monkeys, Sloths, Mantled Howlers, Toucans, Spectacled Owls, Parrots, Coatis and Butterflies! Only here, you will get the opportunity to shake a Spider Monkey's hand or to feed a Toucan!

Duration: approx. 4 hours, Max. Capacity: 40pax / round (2 rounds / day)



San Blas Experience

We will take you off for an exciting full day adventure on the islands of the famous San Blas archipelago, interacting with one of the indigenous communities of Guna Yalas. Here you will enjoy the white sand beaches, crystal-clear water and palm trees. Just lay back, relax and enjoy this day trip to this famous, but still somehow untouched paradise. Duration: approx. 12 hours, Max. Capacity: 60pax / round (2 rounds / day)

Panama La Vieja Cathedral

Panama La Vieja was the very first European settlement on the Pacific side. After pirates ransacked the city in search for gold in the 1670s, they left nothing but ruins. The Cathedral of Panama La Vieja is one of these historical monuments and a perfect backdrop for a gala dinner. Max. capacity: 600pax



Panama La Vieja Convent

Panama La Vieja was the very first European settlement on the Pacific side. After pirates ransacked the city in search for gold in the 1670s, they left nothing but ruins. Once a convent for the Conception Nuns, this historical monument is now the perfect setting for a gala dinner. Max. capacity: 250pax



Miraflores Locks

The Miraflores Locks not only serve as a day activity, but also as an evening venue. Host a sunset cocktail, gala dinner, or both on the panoramic terrace at the very feet of the Panama Canal with views over container ships passing by 24/7.

Max. capacity: 300pax



Mi Pueblito

Mi Pueblito is a replica of a traditional countryside Panamanian village with a town square, small houses, a church, a barber shop, a school and a museum, offering the perfect setting for a real Panamanian evening that comes to life with traditional food and entertainment. Max. capacity: 300pax



American Trade Hall

The American Trade Hall was originally built as a branch of the National City Bank of New York, modelled after the branch at 417 Broadway in downtown Manhattan. Its interiors feature ornate columns and floors laid with reclaimed old-growth timber acquired through underwater logging in the Panama Canal. The hall features the perfect background for formal events or dinners. Max. capacity: 350pax



Interoceanic Museum

Established in 1997, the museum is devoted to the history of the construction of the Panama Canal, including the first French construction attempt, the later construction by the United States, and the eventual transfer to Panamanian control, offering a big entrance hall surrounded by elegant French doors, shiny black marble floors and white, antique brass locks, as well as natural and artificial lighting. Max. capacity: 250pax



French Plaza

Located in The Casco (Old Quarter), the Plaza is called the French Plaza to commemorate the French initiating the building of the Panama Canal. The building used to be where prisoners were held centuries ago, but is now an upscale restaurant and beautiful historical backdrop for a gala dinner. Max. capacity: 600pax



Biomuseum

The Biodiversity Museum is located on the Amador Causeway and was designed by renowned architect Frank Gehry (Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao, Spain). Due to its unique architecture and its stunning location between the Panama bay and the entrance to the Panama Canal, this is a truly unforgettable venue for any kind of memorable event. Max. Capacity: 350pax

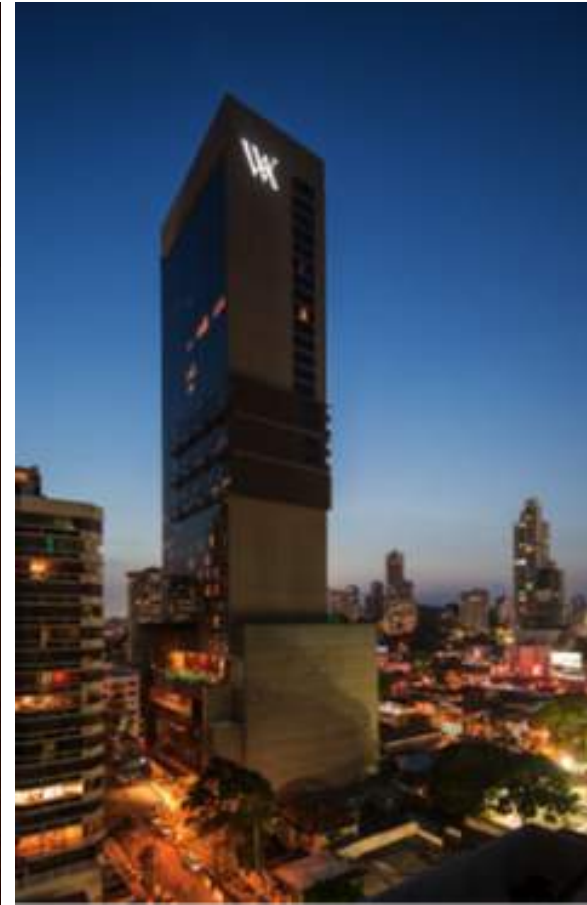
