Finish the tour with the trendy neighborhoods of Palermo and Recoleta with their wonderful parks, stores, mansions, museums, and amazing monuments and avenues.



Estancia Villa Maria

Estancia Villa Maria is located 50 kilometers away from Buenos Aires' City and just 15 minutes ride from Ezeiza International Airport. Estancia El Ombu

El Ombú de Areco, an historical estancia (ranch) just over an hour's drive from downtown Buenos Aires, is located in San Antonio de Areco, birthplace of the gaucho tradition. The Late-Colonial style mansion, built in 1880 by Lieutenant-general Pablo Riccheri, offers visitors a magnificent setting for an unforgettable stay.



Estancia La Porteña

One of the 1000 Places to see before you die in Patricia Schultze's famous book, Estancia La Porteña is known as the "cradle of Argentine tradition". The main house was built in the 19th century and the park around it was designed by the French landscape professional Charles Thays. Later it was declared National Historic Monument.



View a Private Polo Match at an Estancia

Also known as the "Sport of Kings", the Polo has in Argentina it's maximum exponents, standing among them Mr. Adolfo Cambiasso, considered to be the best Polo Player in the history of this sport. His family will welcome you for a Polo clinic and enjoy a demonstration Polo Match with a typical Argentine Barbecue. This experience will not only give you the opportunity to learn some Polo skills but also to see from inside this fascinating world including the horses, the stables and the histories narrated by players and most important the members of the best polo teams around the world.



Recoleta Walking Tour

This wonderful district is known for its squares, parks, cafés and one of Argentina's most important cemeteries, which holds Evita Peron's much-visited grave. Beautiful churches, cultural centers and galleries like the Palais de Glace, fill the neighborhood with culture and history. It has been referred to as the Paris of the Americas due to the many palaces and villas in the area, which also offers sophisticated restaurants, up-scale shopping the city's most luxurious hotels.



Museums of Buenos Aires

Buenos Aires is a culturally rich city and has many museums. The tour starts at the Isaac Fernández Blanco Hispanic-American Art Museum, then moves on to the Peruvian neocolonial-style Palacio Noel, a wonderful and unique museum. Most of the silver items, wood carvings, furnishings and paintings from the Spanish colonial period that are on display were donated by the original owners of the houses that are now the museums.



Malba Museum

Museum of Latin American Arts, was set up to collect, conserve, study and disseminate Latin American art, dating from the early 20th Century to the present day. It's collection is institutional owned by Eduardo F. Costantini Foundation and composed of over 270 works by Latin American artists. Most of its works were donated by Malba's founder, issuing from his private collection acquired during the 1980's and 1990's. Since the beginning of the public operation, its collection has grown due to the acquisition program and to donations made by artists and individual donors.



Colon Theatre Visit

The Teatro Colón is one of the most famous opera houses in the world. It opened in 1908 after being under construction for twenty years, it has 2,367 seats and a standing room for 1,000. Over the years, this magnificent opera house has hosted many great names as Titta Ruffo, Amelita Galli-Curci, Giacomo Lauri-Volpi, Arturo Toscanini, Jane Bathori, Enrico Caruso, Jon Vickers, John O'Sullivan, Renata Tebaldi, Plácido Domingo, Ástor Piazzolla and Luciano Pavarotti.



San Telmo Antiques & Flea Market Visit

The *Feria de San Telmo* is one of the most notable and popular events that takes place in Buenos Aires. Nestled in one of the oldest neighborhoods in Buenos Aires, the San Telmo Fair is bustling with unique artisans and antiques every Sunday from about 10am to 4pm (depending on the season and the weather). Perhaps its greatest qualities, besides the architecturally beautiful neighborhood which it calls home, are its exclusive goods and reliable nature. Never a Sunday will there be without tourists pouring into the cobblestone streets of San Telmo for one of a kind antiques, trinkets, art, tango and delicious food.



Evita & Peronism Tour

Her popularity continues feeding the power base of the Partido Justicialista (Justicialista Party), whose members call themselves peronistas to this day. You will discover the fascinating personality of Evita, and the main features of the Peronist movement that her husband, Juan Perón, founded and led for thirty years (1945-74). This visit is specially recommended for those interested in the recent history of Argentina, and it is also recommended to anyone who wishes to understand more about this country's present-day politics and society.



Buenos Aires by Bike

Start out in San Martin Square, go through Puerto Madero, the Natural Reservoir and end up in La Boca. After a well deserved stop, ride back through San Telmo and May Square. 


La Ventana Tango

Zanjon de Granados

Circulo Militar

Built in the XIX century it was designed by a French architect inspired in the renaissance period and Luis XVI. Museo Nacional de Arte Decorativo

Built in the 1920's, formerly owned by one of Buenos Aires' most influential families: Errázuriz-Alvear. The family palace was acquired by the Argentine State to become the first Decorative Museum of the City, in 1937. It was declared a historic monument in 1997.


Sottovoce





Go sailing the rapids on inflatable boats (6km boat trip on Iguazu River with 2km of rapids). And finally jump into the jungle for an 8km ride boarding an all-terrain vehicle through the path Yacaratiá to Puerto Macuco.



Iguazu Forest

- **Canopying:** The platforms are set on the top of the highest trees, and the adventurer slides from one tree to the next hanging with harnesses from a strong steel cable. This is the canopying, a new form of enjoying nature with airborne adrenalin as the main character. The platforms heights vary from 15 to 25 meters along 800 meters of thrill.
- **Hiking the jungle:** Following trails though the jungle, recognizing species of the flora and fauna. The circuit is 900 meters long.
- **Wet Rappelling:** Under close supervision of the instructors, wearing climbing gear, we do the wet rappel down a 14 meters fall or dry rappel down a 20 meters tall cliff. A powerful experience that makes you feel very confident on yourself!



Visit to Itaipu Hydroelectric plant

A special and full of energy visit: in addition to seeing the famous sights of the Panoramic Tour, you will still get a closer look of the details of the Plant, the architecture of the majestic concrete cathedrals that make up the 196 meters high dam (equivalent to a 65-story building), you will touch and feel the vibration of one of the penstocks, through which pass 700,000 liters of water per second; see the central control room of the Plant, where Brazilian and Paraguayan technicians monitor the energy production for both countries; until you reach the shaft of a turbine in full operation, which alone can generate enough energy to power a city with 2.5 million homes. All these are moments of an extra special and unforgettable visit. Come visit and let Itaipu become part of your history.



Helicopter Experience over the falls

You can take a helicopter ride over the falls. (Americans are requested visas to get into Brazil).The Brazilian side of the falls offers the best panoramic views. At this tour you will see the amazing force of nature at its best!



Boat trip - encounter of the 3 borders (Argentina, Brazil & Paraguay)

The adventure begins with the Paran , where tourists board the Explorer yacht. The yacht has a capacity for 40 passengers and includes American bar, covered deck, solarium, air-conditioned VIP room. The best option to navigate with comfort and tranquility. Passengers will enjoying almost 40-minutes journey through the beautiful postcards of Foz do Igua . The second stage of the tour the yacht docks at Port Bertoni on the Paraguayan side (run by the Paraguayan National Park Service). Walking 800 meters through forest trails, is one of the magic moments of the tour that leads to the old Bertoni family installations, today transformed into a museum. Moises Santiago Bertoni, known locally as "The Wise" was a Swiss botanist, researcher and author. The duration of the ride is approximately 3:30 hours, departing at 09:00 pm and 14:00 pm.



Bird Park Sanctuary visit

Trekking on the Perito Moreno Glacier

The tour to the glacier takes about an hour and a half. Appreciate cracks, crevasses, drains and small ponds. The hike is moderate. The walk is along an irregular ice surface, but firm and safe. On the way back to the port get yourself really close to the glacier's wall and if you like it, enjoy a glass of whiskey with ice from the Perito Moreno Glacier. After arriving to the port walk the catwalks located just in front the glacier from where you can get a different views of the amazing landscape from this balconies and take home an unforgettable picture.



All Glaciers Nautical Safari

Departure at 09:00 am from Punta Bandera port (47 kilometers from the city of El Calafate). Before the departure, the passengers will be informed about the safety rules and navigation conditions. Once aboard, sail through the North Arm of *Lake Argentino* until the *Upsala Channel*, where we will find a spectacular Ice Barrier. Then sail through *Spegazzini Channel*, where we will observe the *Dry Glacier*, until you reach *Spegazzini Glacier*, the highest in the National Park. The return to Punta Bandera Private Port will be at approximately 4:00 pm.

*The route can be modified depending on weather and safety conditions and the decision of the captain of the boat.



Gourmet Glaciers Lake Expedition



Familia Zuccardi, always taking care of every detail, has chosen the best areas to cultivate each variety and the conduction system is chosen according to the regional and varietal characteristics



Chandon Winery

Created in 1959 as the first Moët & Chandon subsidiary out of France this Winery has 1,333 acres of vineyards in the upper river and Uco Valley area. The varieties produced are: Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Chenin, Semillon and Chardonnay.



Salentein Winery

The winery is at an altitude of 1200 meters. The underground cellars are 8 meters deep with a constant temperature of 12 ° C and 80% humidity. 2,000 acres, of which 445 are dedicated to vineyards. Plants are between 4 and 36 years and produce Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Syrah, Tempranillo, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.



Trapiche Winery
