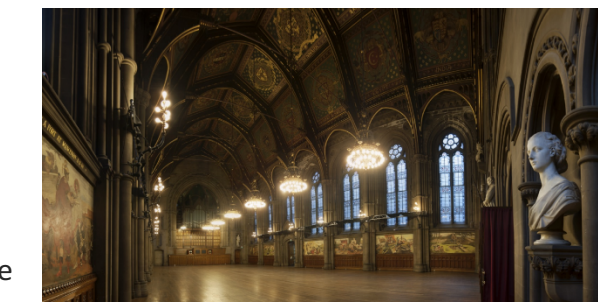

The venue features 10 different types of meeting rooms with the largest room that can accommodate up to 500 guests.

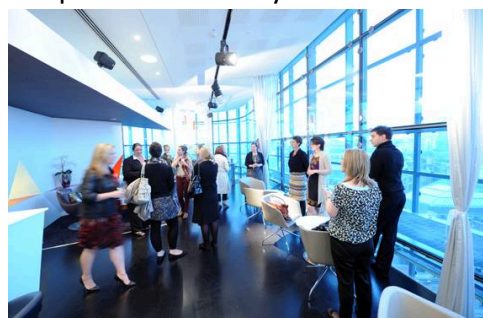
National Football Museum
