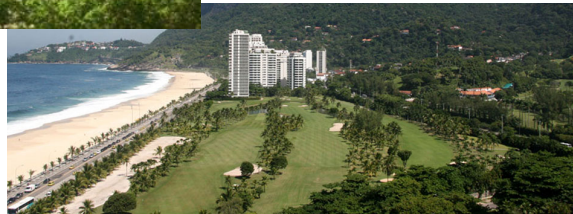


● The Hotel: Grand Melia – Luxury Urban Resort

Jeep Tour – Tijuca Forest + Christ the Redeemer + Lunch + Sugar Loaf Mountain

Tijuca Forest – Embark on an adventure ride through the Tijuca National Park. The largest urban reserve in the world, covering an area of 3.200 hectares.

Christ the Redeemer – One of the new seven wonders of the world that sits 700 meters above sea level on Corcovado Hill. Enjoy breathtaking panoramic view of the city.

Lunch at Aprazível, which stands for “Pleasant” in portuguese

– Taste the fine dining side of Brazil among gardens and terraces with lush vegetation and astonishing views of downtown.

Sugar Loaf Mountain – An iconic symbol of the city, mount Sugar Loaf rises up from a peninsula on the Guanabara Bay

● City Tour – Sitio Burle Marx + Lunch at Mirante da Prainha + West Side Beaches Tour

Burle Marx – The Burle Marx residence from 1973 until 1994, the year of his death, the site is now a special unit attached to the Heritage Institute for National Artistic (IPHAN). Recognized as one of the most important collections of live plants existing in the world, testimony to the profound changes undergone by nature in the country.

Extended lunch at Mirante da Prainha – A small taste of the relaxed beach lifestyle: enjoy the Brazilian fishermen soul food by the preserved Prainha beach, with fresh seafood dishes and capirinhas
